« THE LATEST JHIA COLLECTION'S BACKGROUND/DETAILS »

Hans M. Zell Biodata

ans Zell has been author, editor, and publisher on African topics for more than five decades, and has written extensively on



many aspects of publishing and book development in Africa. addition to number substantial of articles published journals, he is also the author of several books, training manuals, African studies reference

resources.

Swiss-born, Hans Zell started his career in publishing and the book trade in Zurich, followed by stints in Sweden with Almqvist & Wiksell AB, and later with Pergamon Press Ltd in the UK, for a four-year period until 1964. Thereafter his interest turned to Africa, and be became Manager of the Fourah Bay College Bookshop at the University of Sierra Leone from 1965 to 1967. Subsequently, in 1968, he accepted an appointment with Africana Publishing Corporation in New York as its Editor-in-chief for a period of three years, whereupon he returned to Africa again to take up a dual appointment at the University of Ife (now Obafemi Awolowo University) as Editor of the University of Ife Press, and Managing Director of the University of Ife Bookshops at Ile-Ife and Ibadan, for a three-year period until 1973.

Following his engagements in Africa, he became a self-employed consultant, working for several donor and other organizations from his base in Oxford, and in 1975 he founded the quarterly bibliographic and book trade journal *The African Book Publishing Record* https://www.degruyter.com/journal/key/abpr/html (which he edited until 2002), as well as becoming the Founder/Director of Hans Zell Publishers Ltd in Oxford https://www.hanszell.co.uk/history.htm, in later years to become part of the Bowker-Saur group. During this time, he also acted as a consultant to the

Zimbabwe International Book Fair in its early years from 1983-1985.

Following the termination of the Hans Zell Publishers list by Bowker-Saur in 1998, Hans Zell relocated from Oxford to Lochcarron in 2000, a remote village in the Northwest Highlands of Scotland, and from where he continued the imprint (now called Hans Zell Publishing) through the publication of a small range of new reference works on Africa, African publishing, and African studies. (Publishing activities have now ceased.)

In a part-time capacity, he was the Senior Consultant to African Books Collective Ltd from 1986 to 1995, https://www.readafricanbooks.com/publisher-profiles/african-books-collective-timeline/ and between 1979 and 1995 also acted as the Secretary to the Managing Committee/The Jury of the Noma Award for Publishing in Africa (now discontinued, see https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Noma Award for Publishing in Africa.)

« ABOUT THE COLLECTION »

The Hans Zell African studies collections and archive have been donated to the Library of the **Jesuit Historical Institute in Africa (JHIA)** https://www.jhia.ac.ke/, an "institute geared to preserving memory and promoting historical knowledge." The collections include the following:

- A copy of every book published under the Hans Zell Publishers imprint http://www.hanszell.co.uk/ during different periods from 1976 to 2008, as well as those titles published/commissioned while Hans Zell was developing the lists of Africana Publishing Corporation in New York, and later that of the University of Ife Press (now Obafemi Awolowo University Press) in Nigeria.
- A general collection of many reference resources, encyclopaedias, and monographs on Africa, African studies, and African literature (non-fiction only).
- Signed books: A small collection of some 50 author signed books, most with a personal inscription, by well-known African writers and scholars, including past winners of the Noma Award for Publishing in Africa.

Together the collections amount to a total of over 400 books and reference works, the majority of them published in hardcover/cased editions. They are as follows (in date order, most recent periods first):

(1) Hans Zell Publishers/Hans Zell Publishing archives, 1975-2008

Hans Zell (Publishers) Ltd., Oxford, 1975-1980; Hans Zell Publishers, an imprint of K.G. Saur, Munich-London-New York, 1981-1988; Hans Zell Publishers, an imprint of the Bowker-Saur division of Butterworths, London, 1989-1990; Hans Zell Publishers, an imprint of Bowker-Saur, a division of Reed Reference Publishing, London-Melbourne-Munich-New Jersey; 1991-1998;

Hans Zell Publishers, an imprint of James Currey, Oxford, 2001-2002 (2 titles only);

and thereafter to revert to the independent Hans Zell Publishing imprint, Lochcarron, Wester Ross, Scotland, 2003-2008 (no further African studies or other titles were published after 2008).

A total of 114 titles (including new editions) were published under the Hans Zell Publishers imprint, first as a small independent publisher, thereafter under different owners of the imprint, and as an independent again as from 2002. The substantial publishing output over these periods primarily consisted of African studies and African literature reference resources, as well as three monograph series in the field of African studies and African literature. A small number of reference works in disciplines other than African studies were also published.

During the above years Hans Zell Publishers produced a diverse range of much acclaimed reference resources, compiled and edited by Africana librarians, and renowned African studies and African literature scholars in various parts of the world. Hans Zell Publishers titles have been winners (or co-winners) of the Conover-Porter Award – awarded biennially by the Africana Librarians Council of the (US) African Studies Association for "the most outstanding achievement and excellence in Africana bibliography or reference work" – on no less than six occasions. Four journals were published during the period: (back issue runs are *not* included in this collection and archive): *The African Book Publishing Record*, quarterly, 1975- now published by deGruyter (the current volume is vol. 49, 2023.) A complete set of Vol. 1, no.

1, 1975 through vol. 36, no. 4, 2010, was part of a separate "Publishing and Book Development in Africa" collection that was donated to Kwara State University Library in Nigeria in 2015 (see press release at

https://www.hanszell.co.uk/Site/PDFs/Press%20rel ease.pdf.) The other three journals were: Current Contents Africa (1980-, later published by the Frankfurt University Library, ceased in 1993; no back issues available), African Studies Abstracts (1994-2002, later online only). The Journal of Commonwealth Literature (1979-2002, later published by Sage Publications). The quarterly African Studies Abstracts was published in print format on behalf of the Africa-Studiecentrum, Leiden, Netherlands, from no. 25 (1994) through no. 33 (2002). Thereafter it was published online only from vol. 34 onwards; it ceased publication with no. 60 (2017).

It should be noted that for a small number of titles published under the Hans Zell imprint no archival copies are available, for example four editions of *The African Book World & Press: A Directory/Répertoire du Livre et de la Presse en Afrique*, published between 1977 and 1989, with co-editions simultaneously appearing under the imprints of Gale Research Company in Detroit and France Expansion in Paris.

(2) Africana Publishing Corporation, A division of Holmes & Meier Inc., New York, 1968-1970

A total of 26 titles published/commissioned by Hans Zell, while Editor-in-Chief at Africana Publishing Corporation (in later years to become Africana Publishing Company), mostly monographs and collections on African studies and African literature – many co-published with major UK publishers such as Heinemann, Hutchinson, Longman, Routledge, Frank Cass, etc. – as well as a few titles of African fiction and poetry, and a number of reference works.

(3) University of Ife Press [now Obafemi Awolowo University Press], Ile-Ife, Nigeria, 1971-1974

A total of 19 titles were published while Hans Zell was Editor/Director of the Press, as were two journals and a series of law reports (the latter *not* part of the collection).

(4) General African studies collection

These are reference resources - including general reference works and those on specialist topics/disciplines or specific African countries published by a variety of publishers. Additionally, the collection contains monographs and general works on Africa and African studies. African art and cultures. and African literature (critical studies and collections only). African fiction, drama, or poetry is not included, except for signed books, see below. While not a systematically assembled African studies collection and simply consisting of books and reference works collected over several decades – it contains many titles that would probably form part of any core collection on African studies. It comprises a total of 216 titles.

(5) Signed books

A small collection of 52 author signed books, most with a personal inscription, by well-known African writers and scholars, including past winners of the Noma Award for Publishing in Africa, which ran from 1980 to 2009, Hans Zell was Secretary to the Noma Award Managing Committee/the Jury from 1979 to 1995. Some notes on the collection

All Hans Zell Publishers titles are archival copies and are in mint condition. Books which form part of the general African studies collection are also in good condition for the most part (unless otherwise indicated), and many of the more recently published titles are in mint or near-mint condition.

While a number of the reference works are now somewhat dated, many others, regardless of their date of publication, remain valuable print and archival resources for which no digital equivalents exist, nor are they likely to become available in digital formats in the near future. Among the monographs there are a number of classic texts, as well as some more recently published books.

Many of the reference works in the general African studies collection (i.e. those not published by Hans Zell Publishers) were purchased, or obtained for review purposes, during the course of the compilation of two editions of *The African Studies Companion: A Guide to Information Sources*, the 3rd and 4th editions of which were published in 2003 and 2006 respectively, in both print and electronic formats.

(See https://www.hanszell.co.uk/backlist.htm). Most of the books are still in "as new" condition; the majority of them were published in hard-cover or cloth editions, and as such are particularly suitable for use and consultation in an institutional library.

A number of older publications that are now too dated to be of any use (for example some yearbooks or directories) have been discarded. Some older titles available only in paperback formats have also been discarded from the collections as they are not likely to stand up to prolonged use in a library lending environment.

How to search the collection catalogue

Searches for books by author (or by subject) can be made by using the Ctrl+F(ind) function when accessing the catalogue. For example, typing 'McIlwaine, John' into the search box will find four books/reference works written by this academic and author. Or a search for 'Lindfors' will find twelve books by this prolific author.
